

ALAMEDA COUNTY CARE ALLIANCE FORMATION:

In 2014, 5 denominationally diverse African-American pastors in Alameda County recognized increasing problems with serious health concerns among their congregants and poor integration of spiritual concerns into health care for those with serious illness. In response, with input from congregants, health systems, community groups and national organizations, the Alameda County Care Alliance Advanced Illness Care Program™ was developed. Now with over 14 churches, the ACCA program helps to bridge the gap between health delivery systems, community organizations and faith-based communities in managing advanced illness.

Over the last 2 years, the Advanced Illness Care Program[™] has helped over 2,200 persons needing care and caregivers.



WHAT IS AN **ADVANCED ILLNESS?**

An advanced illness is where health

afflicted with the illness, but also family

members, friends, and caregivers.

Through a series of worsens over time and treatment becomes 10 in-person meetings and phone less helpful. Serious advanced illnesses are conversations over 6 months. difficult to deal with physically, emotionally, and spiritually - not only for individuals

the Care Navigator will help congregants and community members meet their advanced illness care needs and link them to resources:

In addition, navigators provide participants with tools, enhanced skills, and empowerment for more efficient communication with their clinicians and health management.

Care Navigators are active faith community members who are trained in community outreach and advanced illness care support.
